RE: How to Drop a No Contact Order

Dear Victim:

To request a hearing for the No Contact Order currently protecting you to be vacated, you will need to have an educational session with a legal advocate from the Council on Domestic Abuse (CODA.) **Please call the CODA office at 812-238-9577.**

What will happen next?

They will request to set up a meeting. Those meetings can take place at either the CODA office in Vigo County Courthouse, Clinton Public Library or the Vermillion County Public Library. If you are unable to attend in person due to extenuating circumstances such as a disability, hospitalization or inability to travel you may request that the session occur via telephone. This meeting will go over some information, give you time to talk about what happened and how you are feeling about resuming contact.

What YOU need to do after this meeting.

After this meeting they will provide court documents to file here in the Vermillion County Clerk's Office, located on the 3rd floor of the Courthouse in Newport, IN. You can also file the said paperwork via USPS by mailing it to PO Box 10 Newport, IN 47966. After this has been filed the Judge will review it and set it for hearing at which you will be required to appear.
